

# Scout Skills & Advancement Outing

## April 20-22, 2001

### General Information

This should be a great weekend of fun, advancement, and review of all of the basic Scout skills. Mrs. Moore is organizing the adults and some of the more experienced Scouts to put on a weekend in which almost all of the skills required for Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class will be taught, reviewed, put to use, and tested. If you have not yet earned First Class, this will be a great opportunity to learn and demonstrate proficiency for rank advancement. If you have earned First Class, this is your opportunity to review and perfect your skills by helping to teach. Get your patrol together and go for 100% attendance!

The camping fee for this outing is \$10 per person attending. The outing fee must be turned in by Tuesday, April 17 to Dancy Moore. A \$10 food deposit must be turned in to the person buying food for your patrol by Tuesday, April 17. The signed Parental Permission form must be turned into your driver on Friday night.

This is a car camping trip. We will drive to where we camp. Therefore, weight and bulk are less of a problem than on a backpacking trip. It is expected that Patrols will take this opportunity to plan fancy, multi-course meals and to set up neat, well-planned campsites. Camporee-type campsites would be appropriate (i.e. patrol box, menu and duty roster posted, table at which Patrol sits all at once to consume meals, etc.). Patrol menus must be written and approved by your Patrol Advisor by Tuesday, April 17.

Please do not bring disposable eating utensils (cups, plates, silverware). Glass and aluminum must be saved separately for recycling.

Transportation for this outing will be organized by each Patrol. Class B Uniforms are required for travel between Claremont and Firestone Scout Reservation both on Friday night and Sunday night.
